Superintendent Kelchen- Legislative update Governor Reynolds vetoed the bill which allowed school to charge for dropping of concurrent enrollment courses and required that they be taught face to face. 8th graders playing sports is in affect and we will wait on guidance from the associations and the Department of Education.
